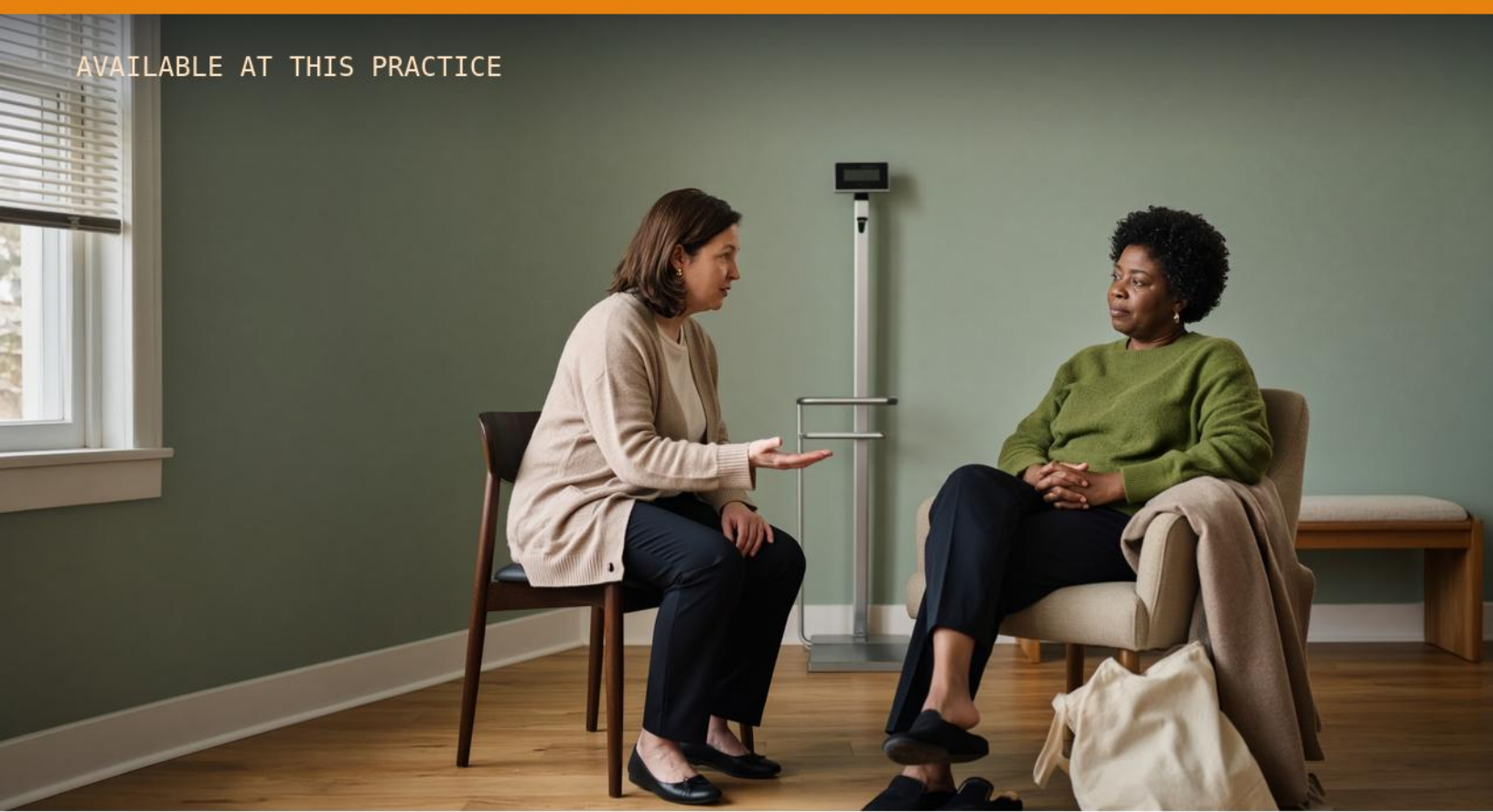


AVAILABLE AT THIS PRACTICE



Before you start, a baseline blood panel.

Thyroid, liver, lipids, glucose and hormones, from one morning draw. It records where your numbers sit now, so there is something to compare them against later. The pharmacogenetic swab is a separate test of how your body processes certain prescription medicines; it does not predict weight loss or say which weight medicine will suit you.

- One morning draw, taken here in the practice
- The cheek swab reads how you process certain medicines — it says nothing about weight loss
- Whether either test is right for you is your clinician's call
